GDPR Compliance

What we collect

The information we collect is names, addresses, telephone number(s) and email addresses.

Lawful Basis

We are relying on Legitimate Interests as our lawful basis for collecting the above information. We believe that you would expect us to collect this information in order to keep you informed of the club's activities.

Purpose

The purpose of collecting this information is to make contact with you, preferably, but not exclusively, by email, to share information about forthcoming concerts. Occasionally we may also provide information on events involving other music groups.

Sharing

Information is held securely by the Chairman on a database, and may be shared with other *ex officio* members of the club committee for legitimate purposes. It will not be shared with any other party without permission of the individual (s) concerned.
